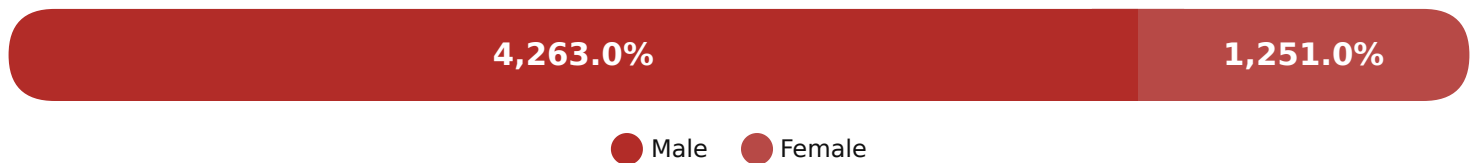
In 2018, there were 5,514 people living with HIV in Boston.

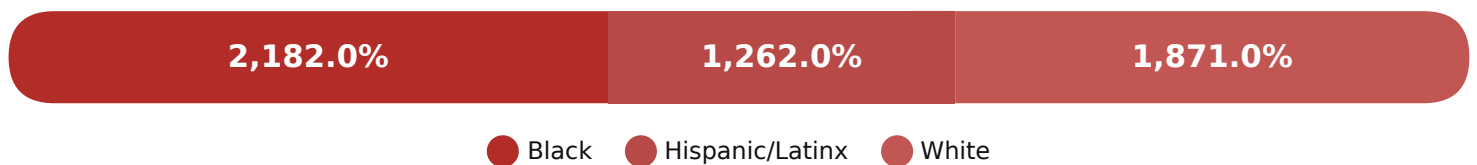

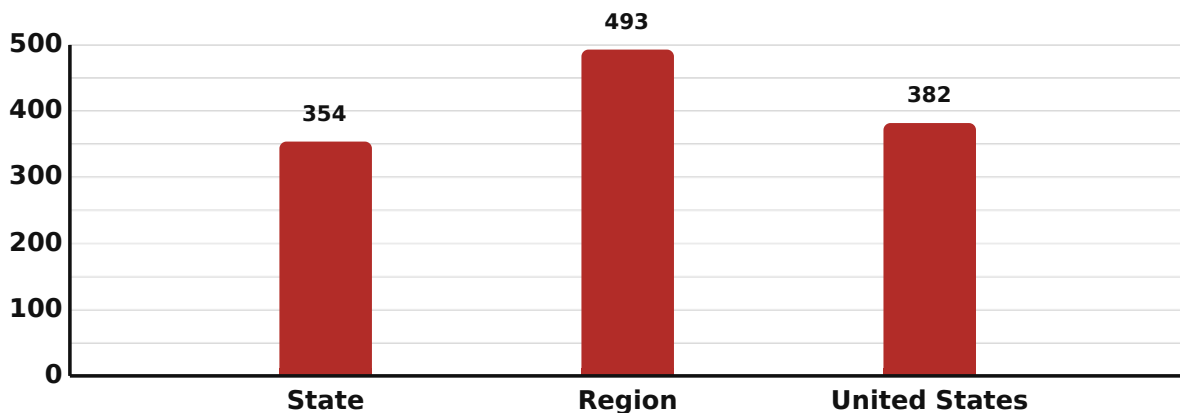
Percent of people living with HIV, by Sex, 2018

Rate of people living with HIV per 100,000 population, by Geography, 2020



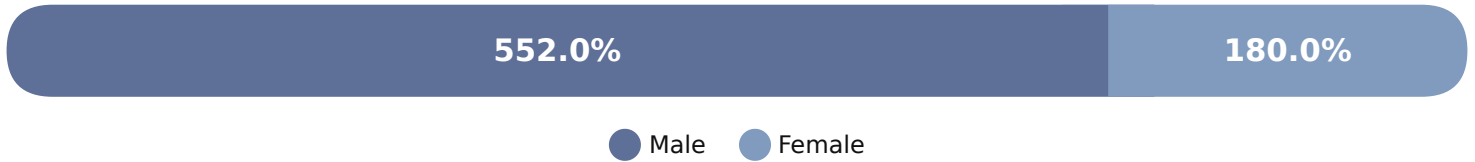

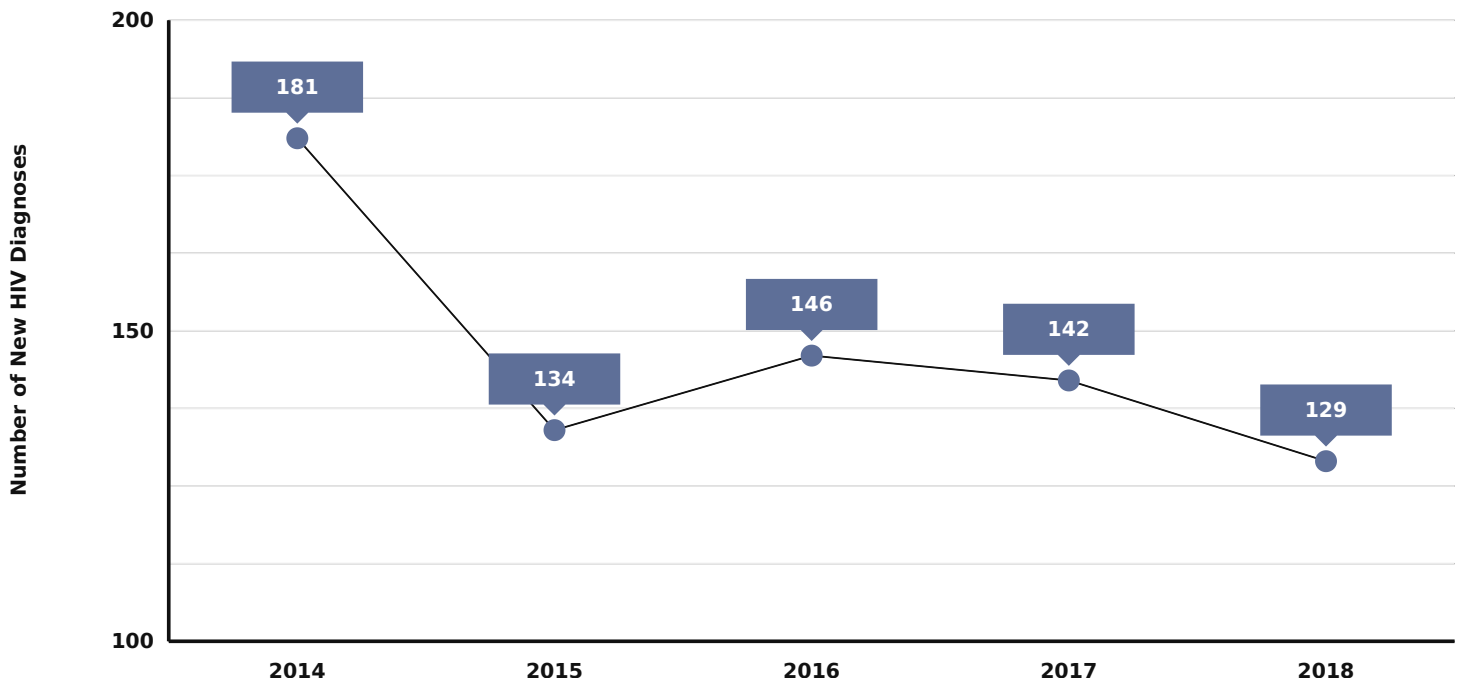
Percent of people newly diagnosed with HIV, by Sex, 2018



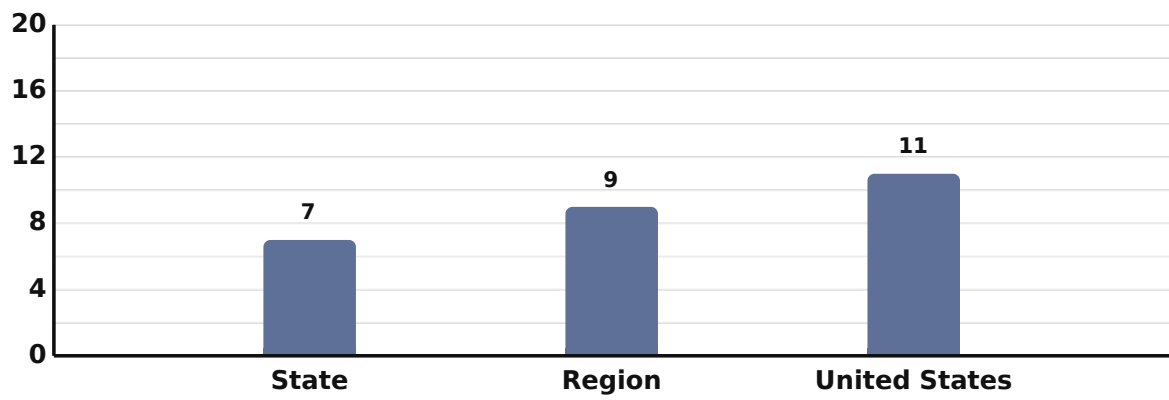
Percent of people newly diagnosed with HIV, by Race/Ethnicity, 2018

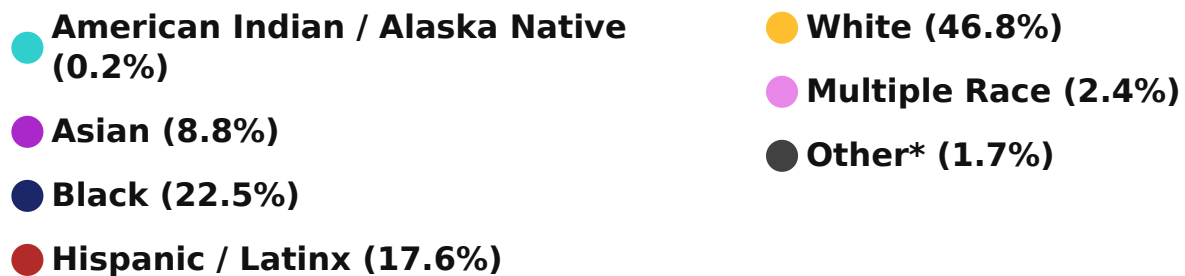

HIV Prevalence Rate Ratios, by Race/Ethnicity, 2018

The rate of **Black males** living with an HIV diagnosis is 2.0 times that of **White males**.

The rate of **Hispanic/Latino males** living with an HIV diagnosis is 1.8 times that of **White males**.

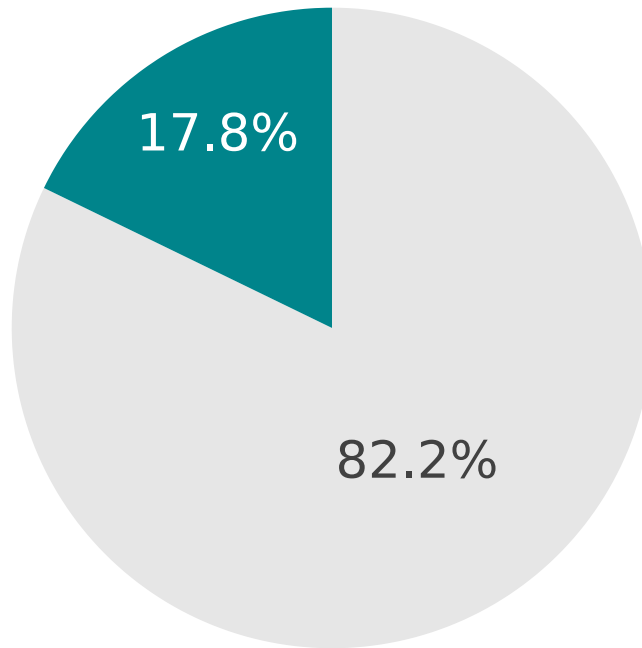
The rate of **Black females** living with an HIV diagnosis is 13.9 times that of **White females**.

The rate of **Hispanic/Latina females** living with an HIV diagnosis is 6.1 times that of **White females**.

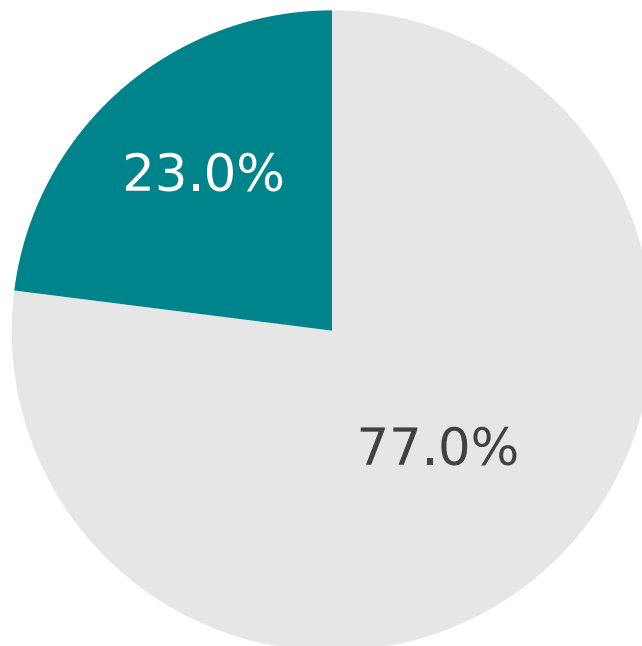
Late HIV Diagnoses, 2020

A late HIV diagnosis is defined as having an AIDS diagnosis within three months of initial HIV diagnosis.

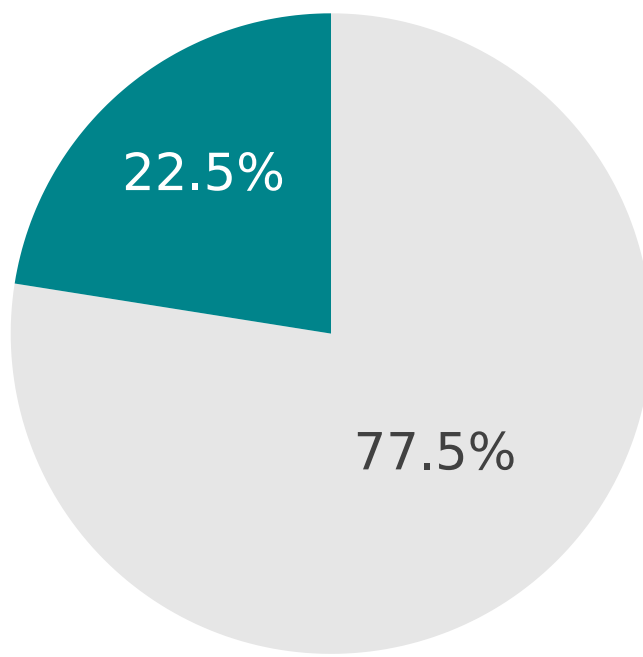

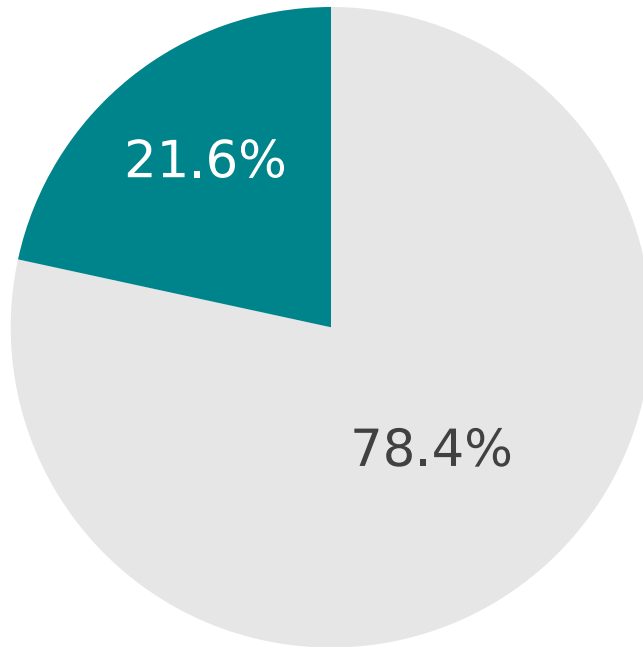

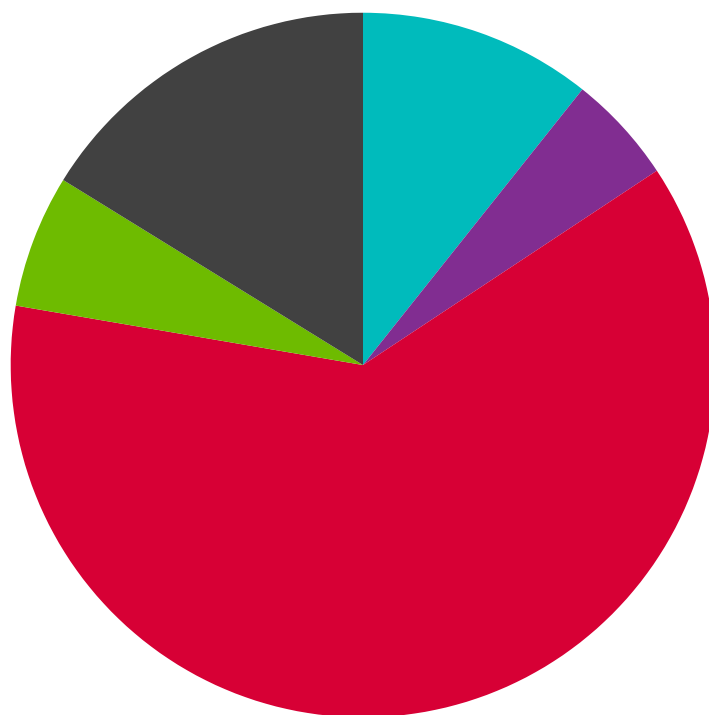

People Living with HIV, by Transmission Category, 2018

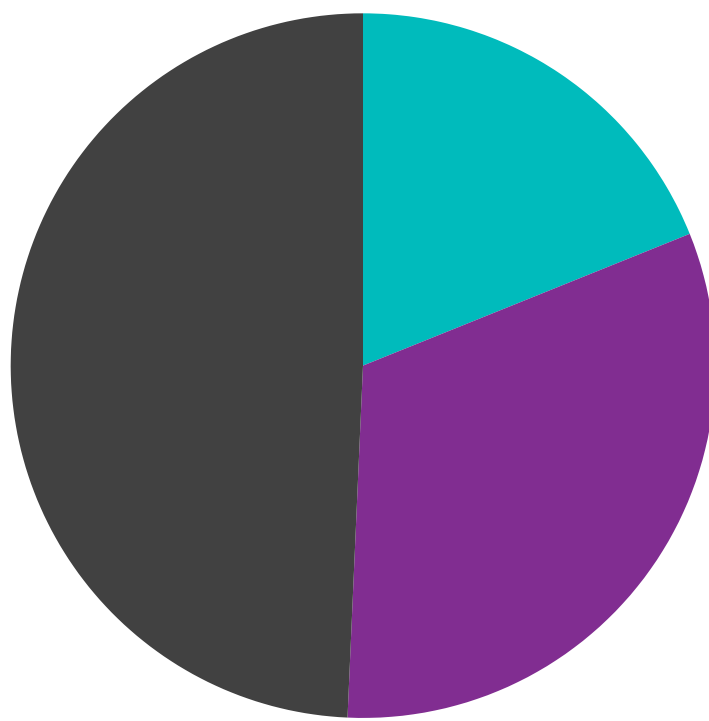

- Injection Drug Use (10.7%)

- Male-to-Male Sexual Contact (62.0%)
- Male-to-Male Sexual Contact & Injection Drug Use (6.1%)

Female Transmission Categories



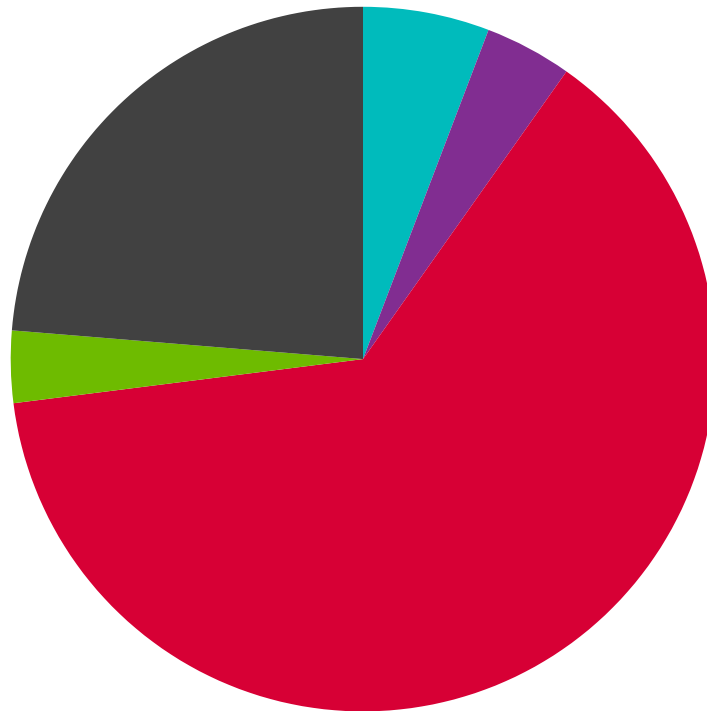
- **Injection Drug Use (18.9%)**

People Newly Diagnosed with HIV, by Transmission Category, 2018

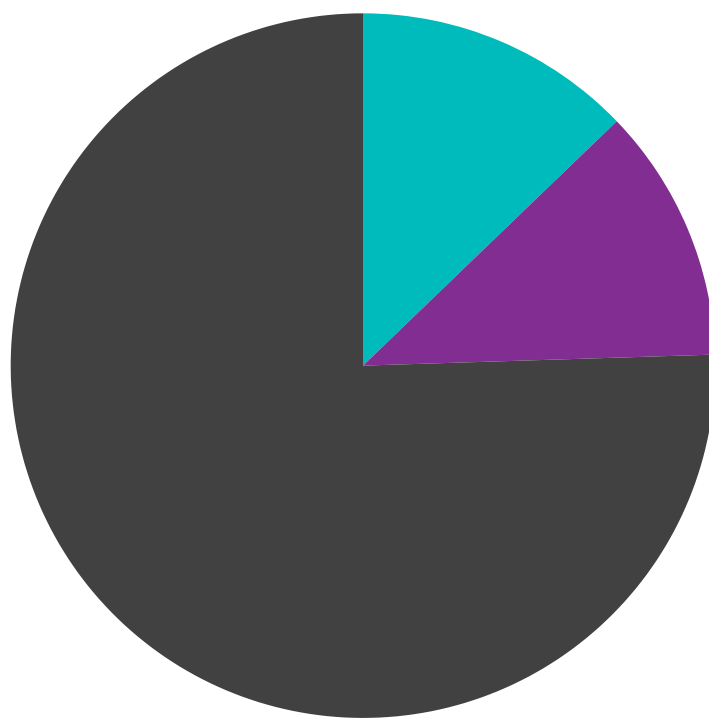

Female Transmission Categories

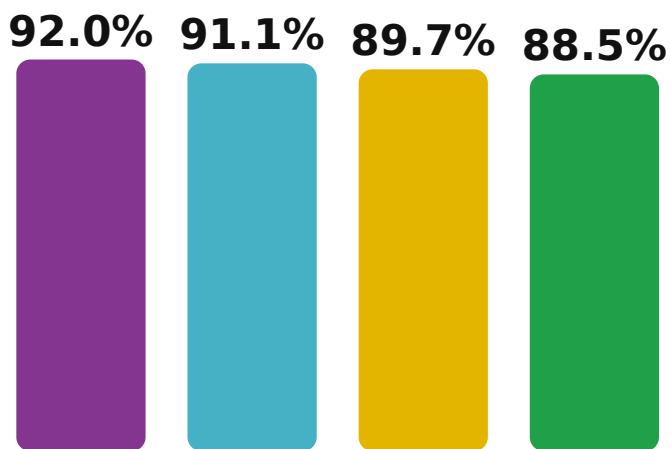


- **Injection Drug Use (12.8%)**

- **Other* (75.5%)**

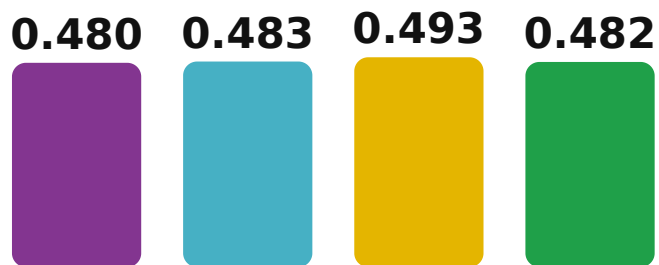

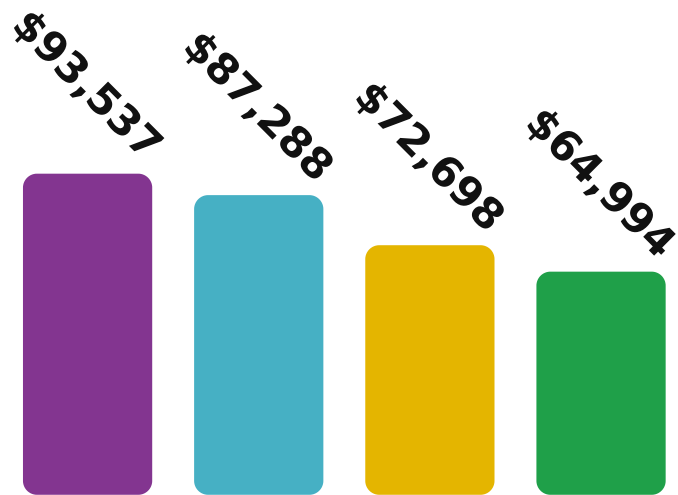

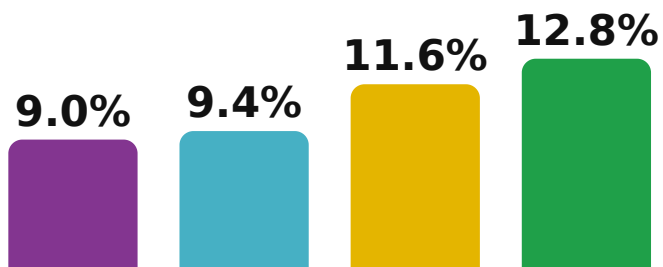
Percent of Population with a High School Education, 2020



Income Inequality (Gini Coefficient), 2020

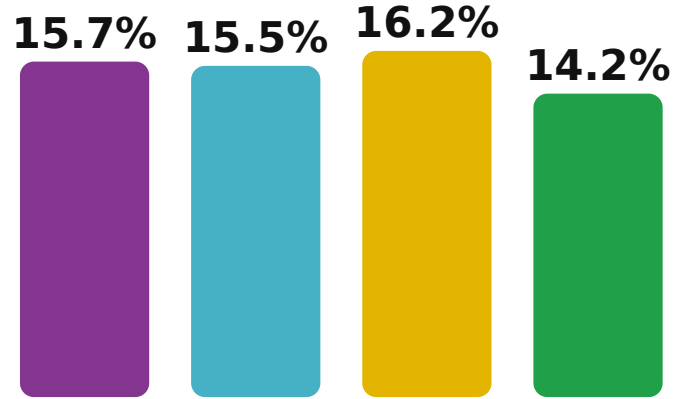
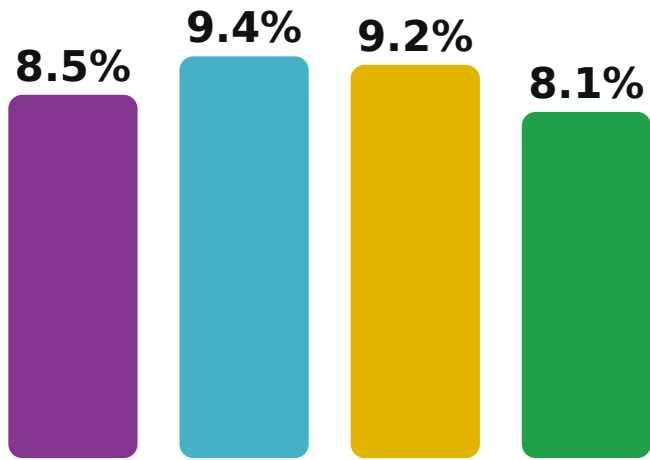


Median Household Income, 2020





Percent of Population Living in Poverty, 2020

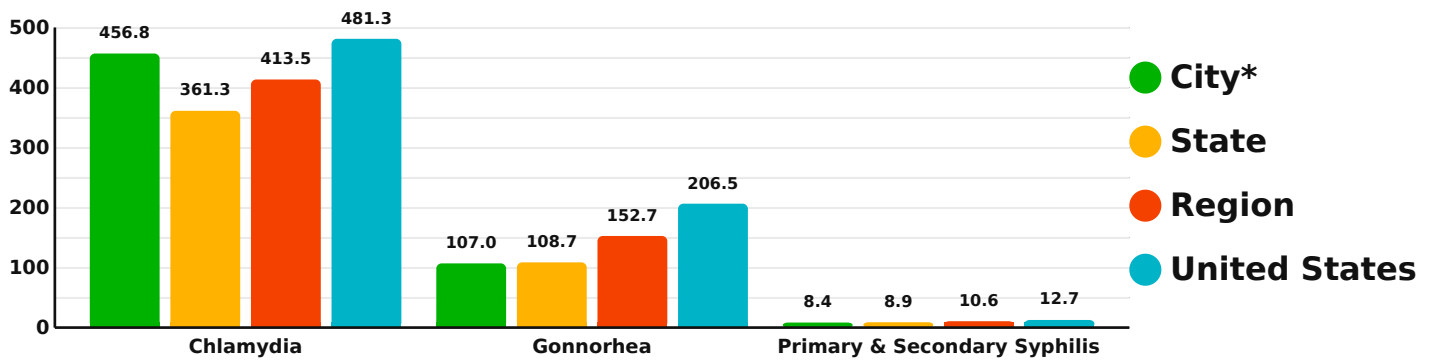


Percent of Population Unemployed, 2020
