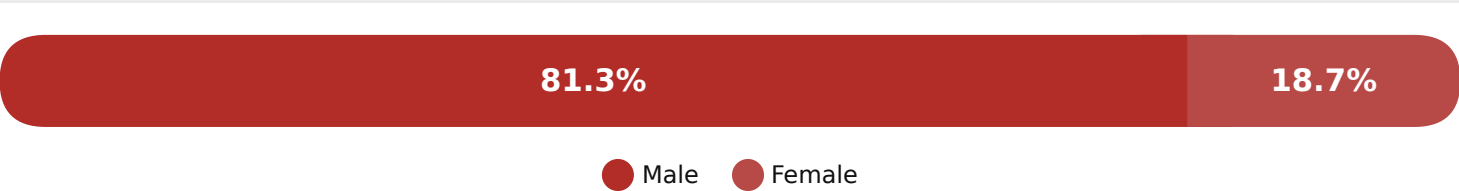

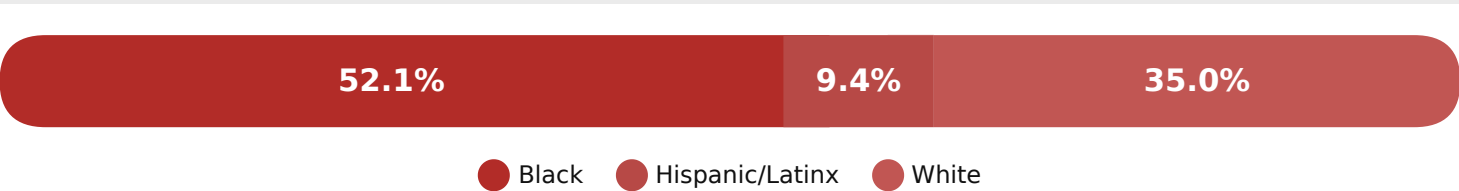

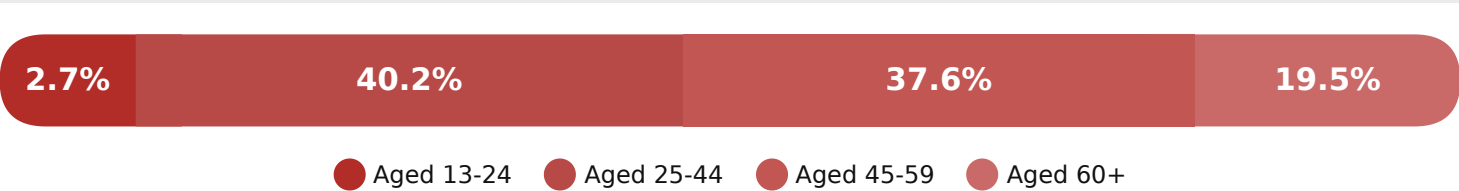
Percent of people living with HIV, by Sex, 2021



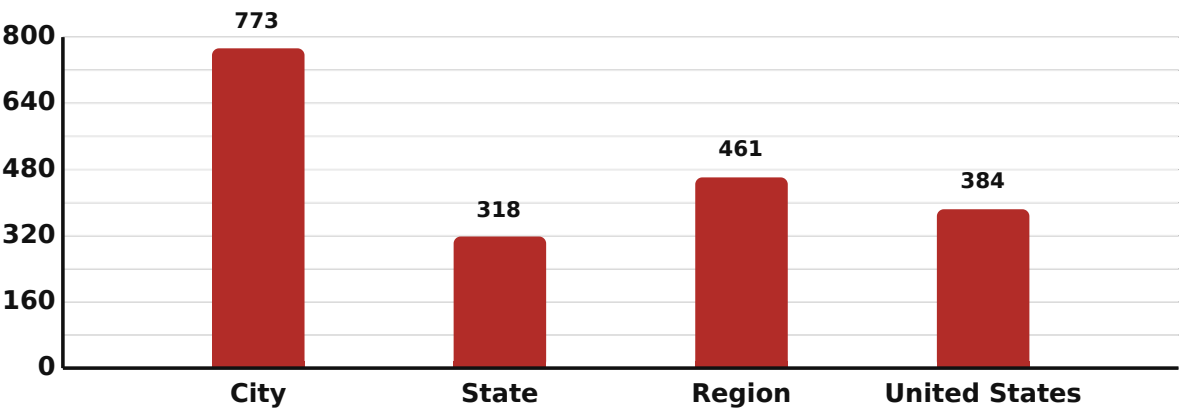
Percent of people living with HIV, by Race/Ethnicity, 2021

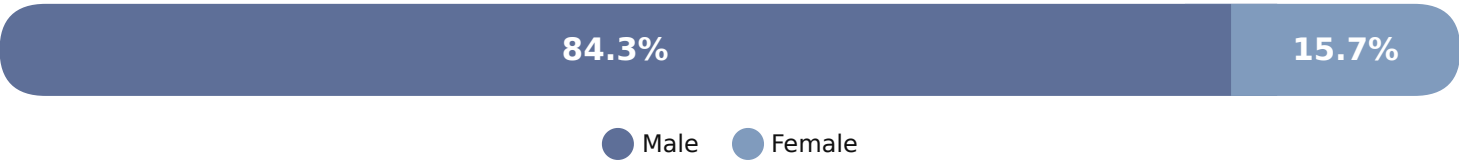

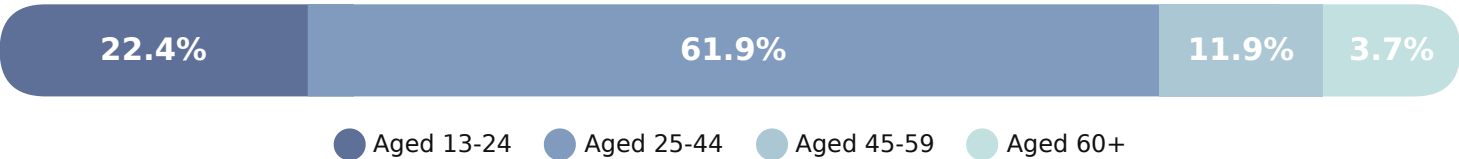
Percent of people newly diagnosed with HIV, by Sex, 2021



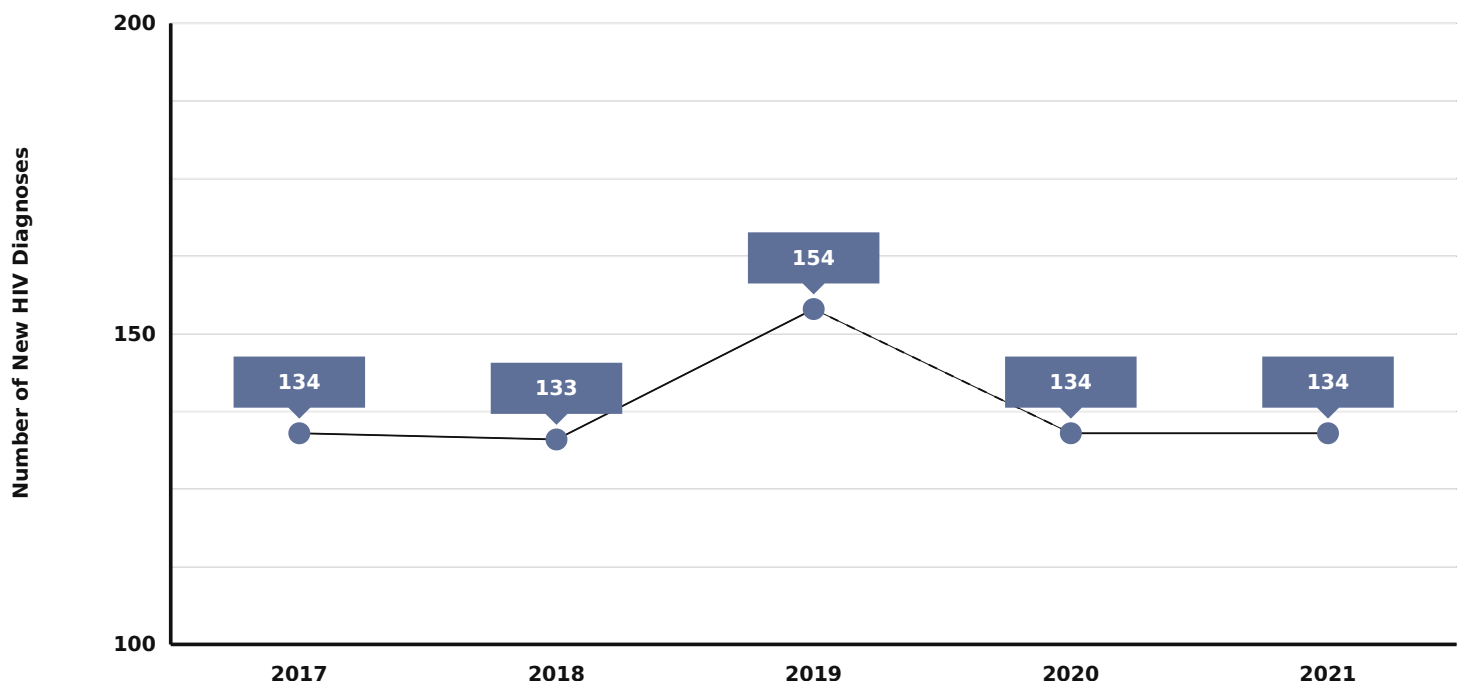
Percent of people newly diagnosed with HIV, by Race/Ethnicity, 2021



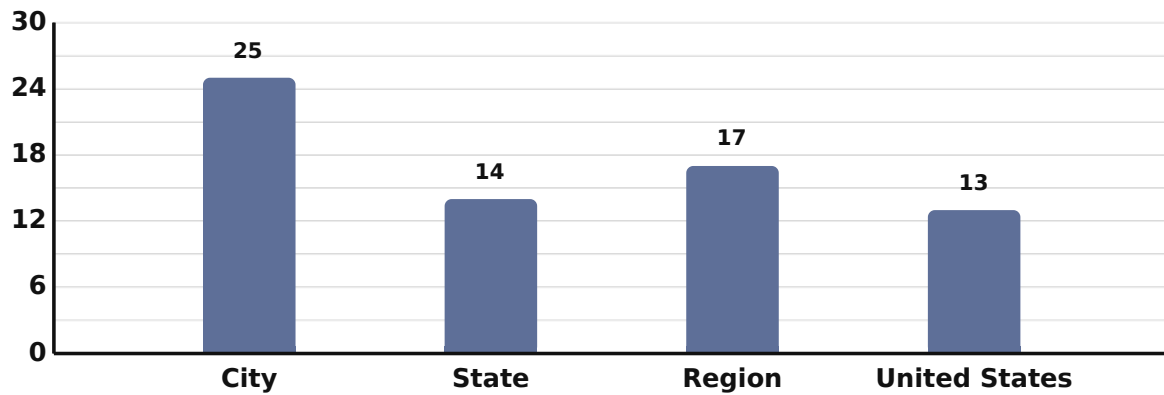
Percent of people newly diagnosed with HIV, by Age, 2021

HIV Prevalence Rate Ratios, by Race/Ethnicity, 2021

The rate of **Black males** living with an HIV diagnosis is 3.1 times that of **White males**.

The rate of **Hispanic/Latino males** living with an HIV diagnosis is 1.7 times that of **White males**.

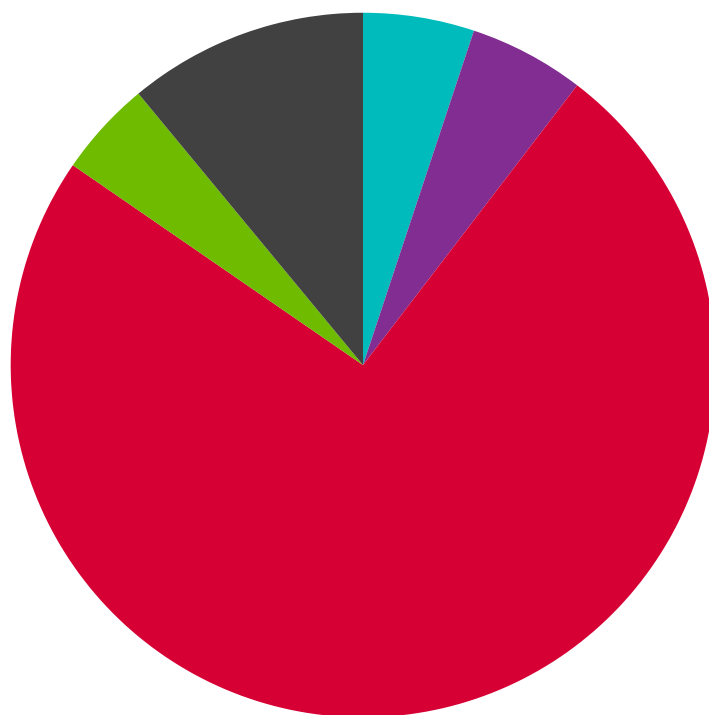
The rate of **Black females** living with an HIV diagnosis is 8.5 times that of **White females**.

The rate of **Hispanic/Latina females** living with an HIV diagnosis is 3.2 times that of **White females**.

People Living with HIV, by Transmission Category, 2021

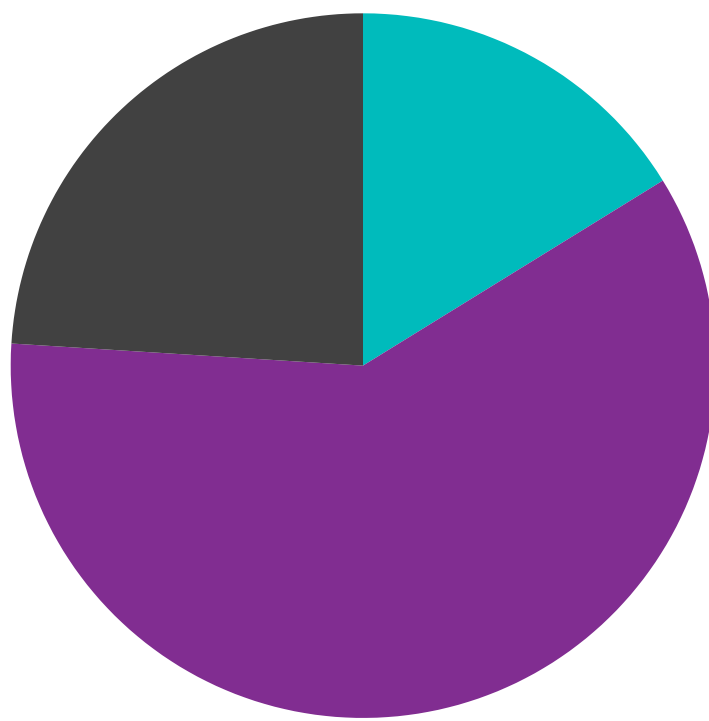

Female Transmission Categories



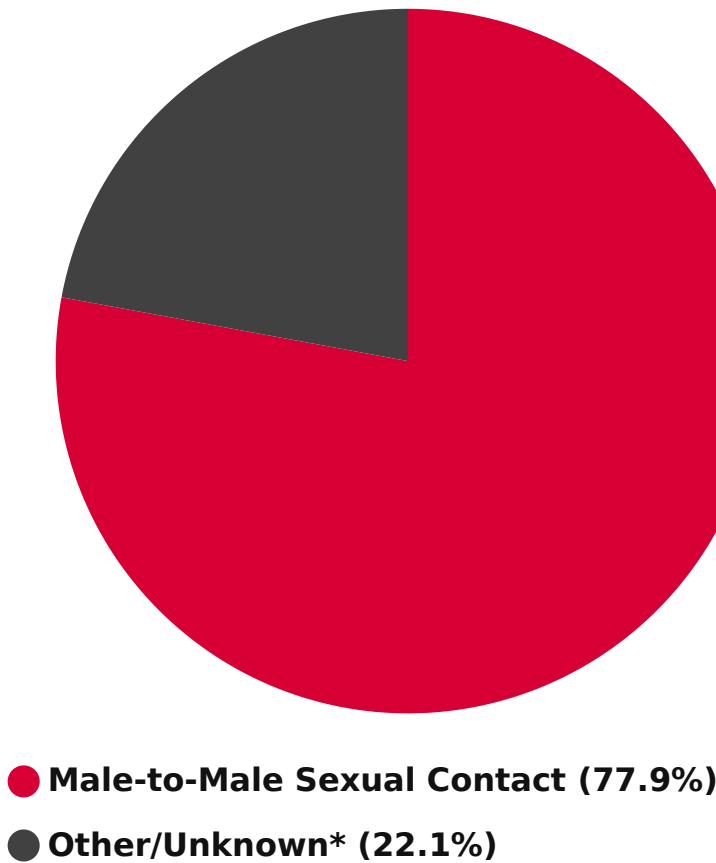

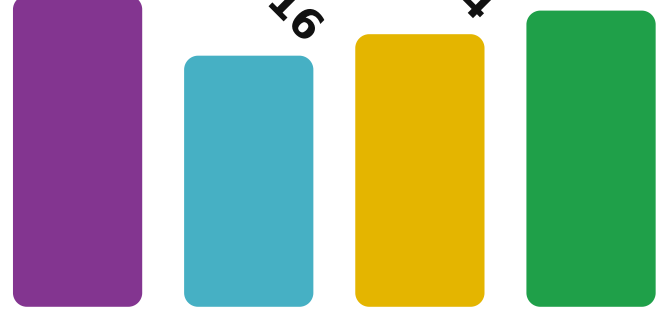

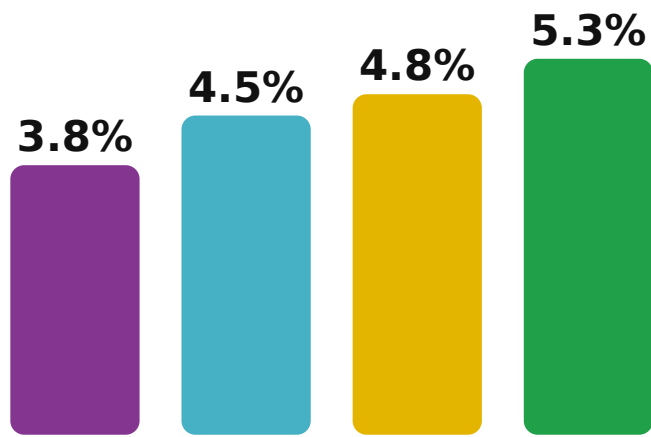


Percent of Population Living in Poverty, 2021

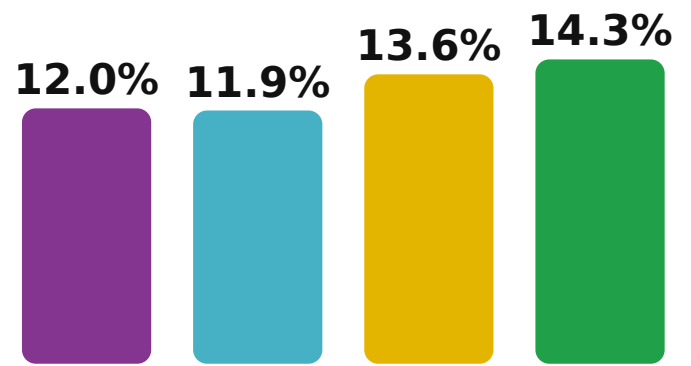
