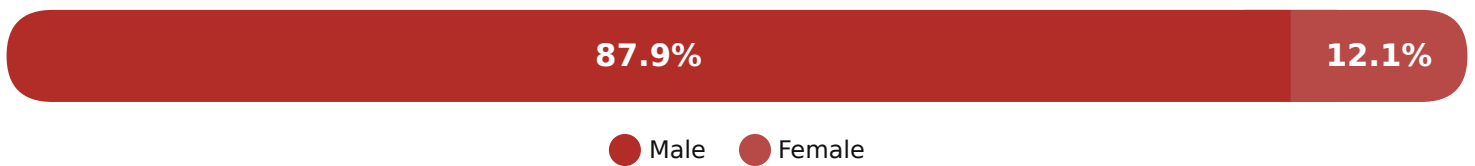

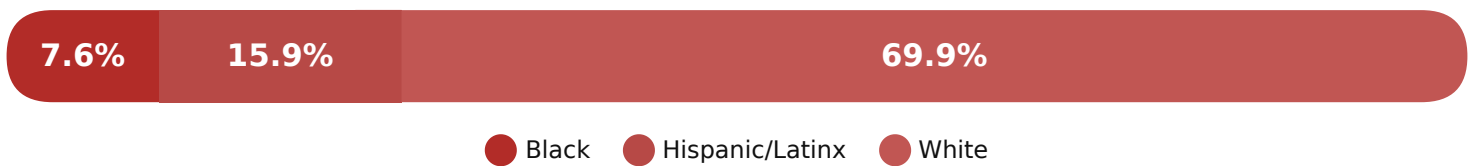

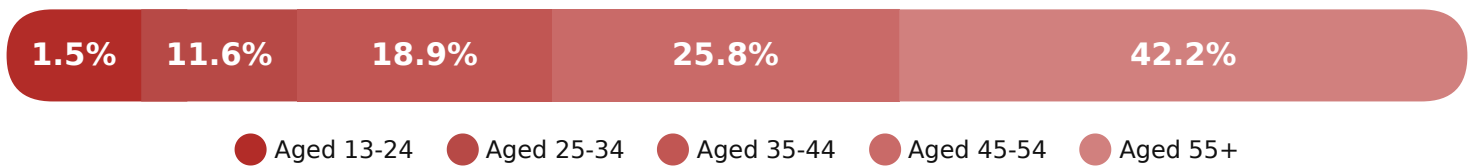
Percent of people living with HIV, by Sex, 2020



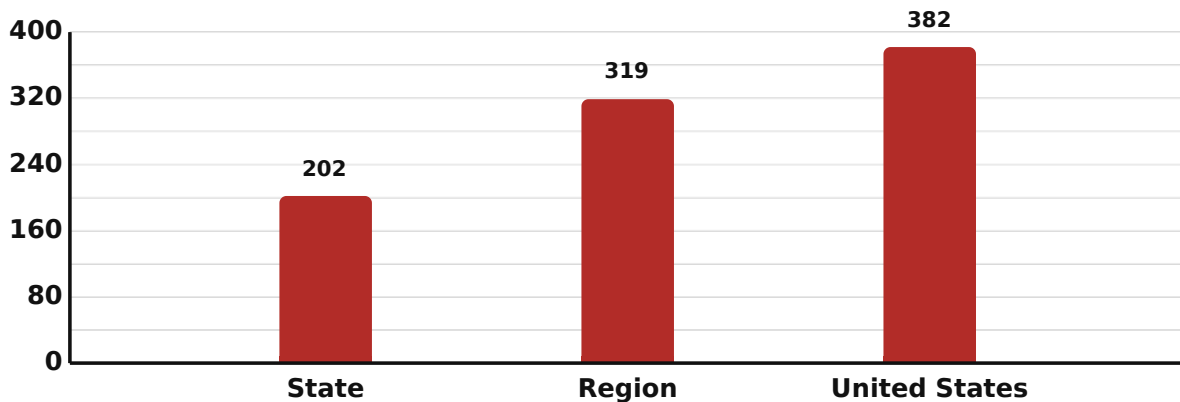
Percent of people living with HIV, by Race/Ethnicity, 2020

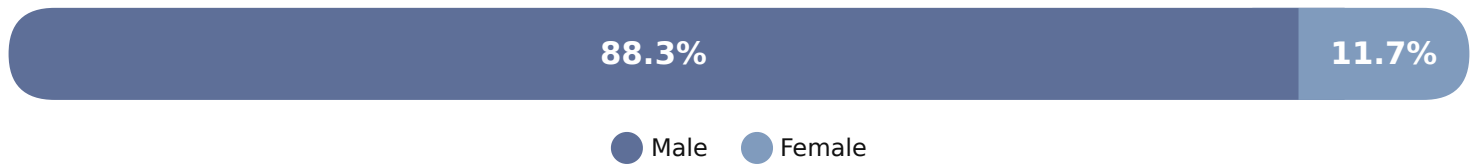

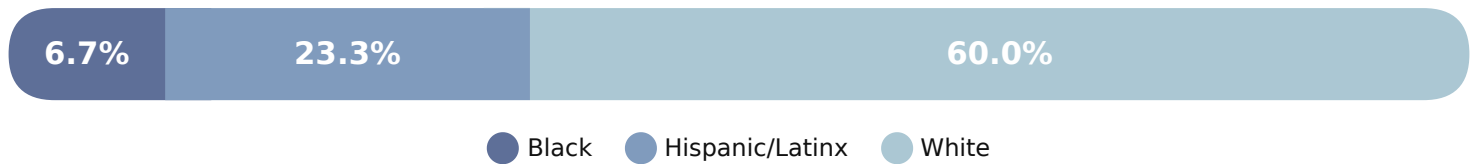

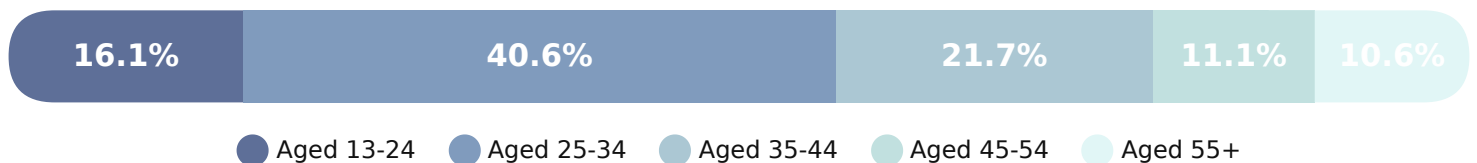
Percent of people newly diagnosed with HIV, by Sex, 2020



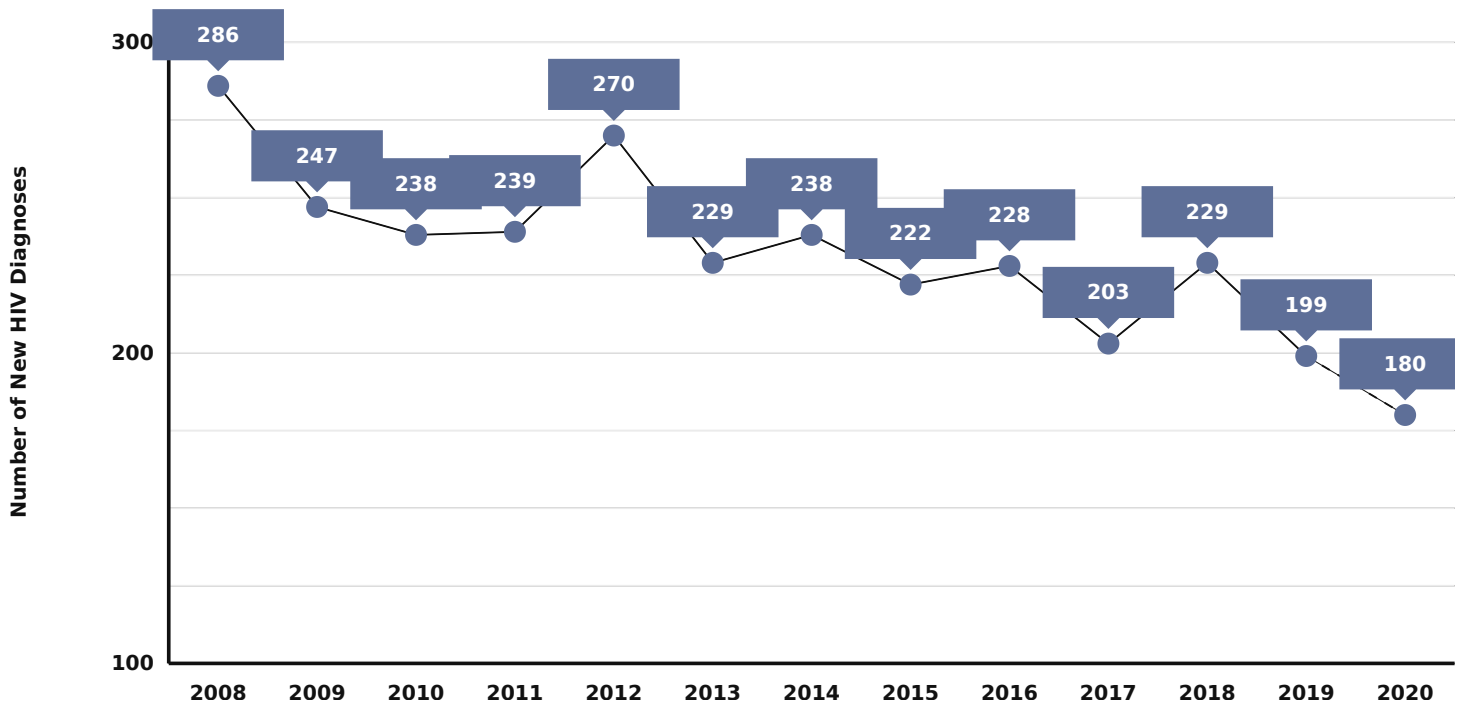
Percent of people newly diagnosed with HIV, by Race/Ethnicity, 2020



Percent of people newly diagnosed with HIV, by Age, 2020

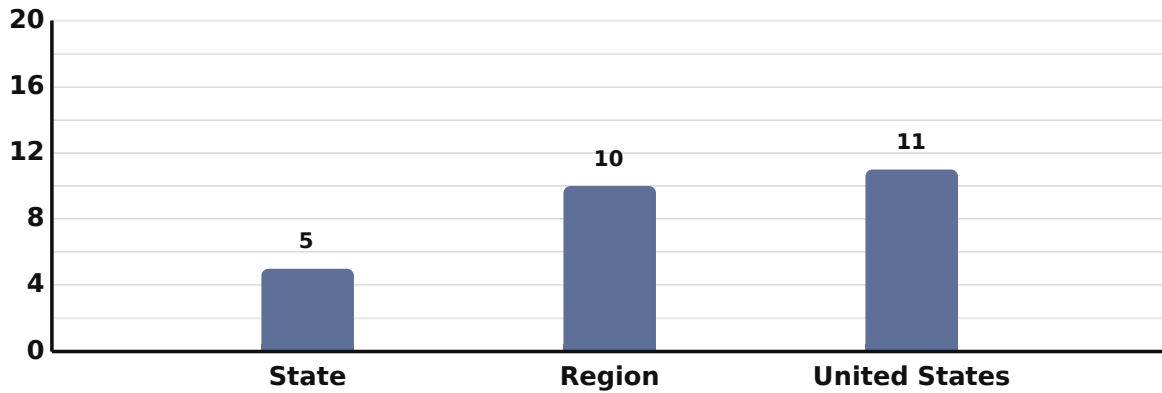


Number of New HIV Diagnoses, 2008-2020

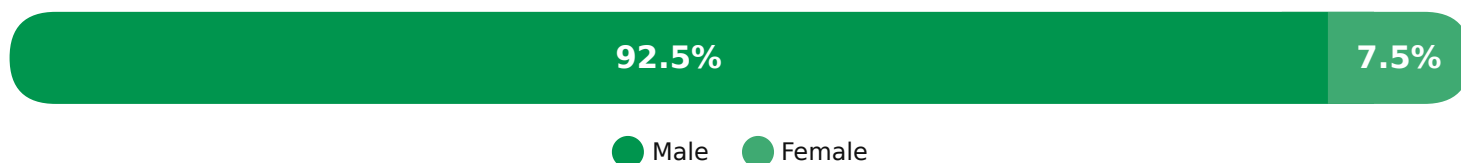

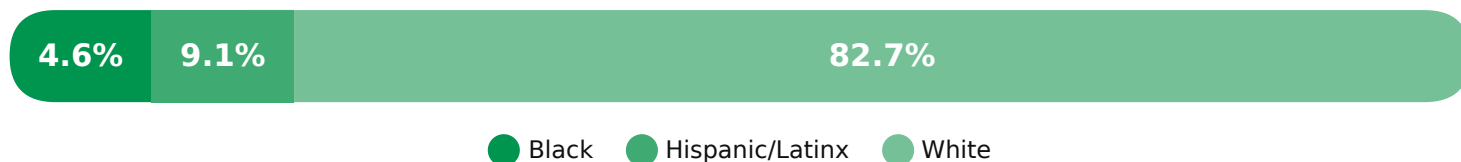

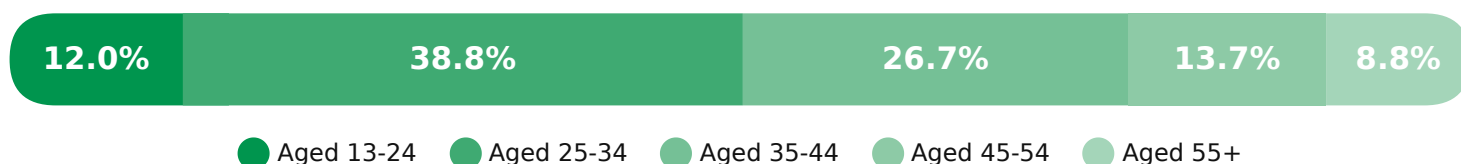
Percent of PrEP users, by Sex, 2021



Percent of PrEP users, by Race/Ethnicity, 2021

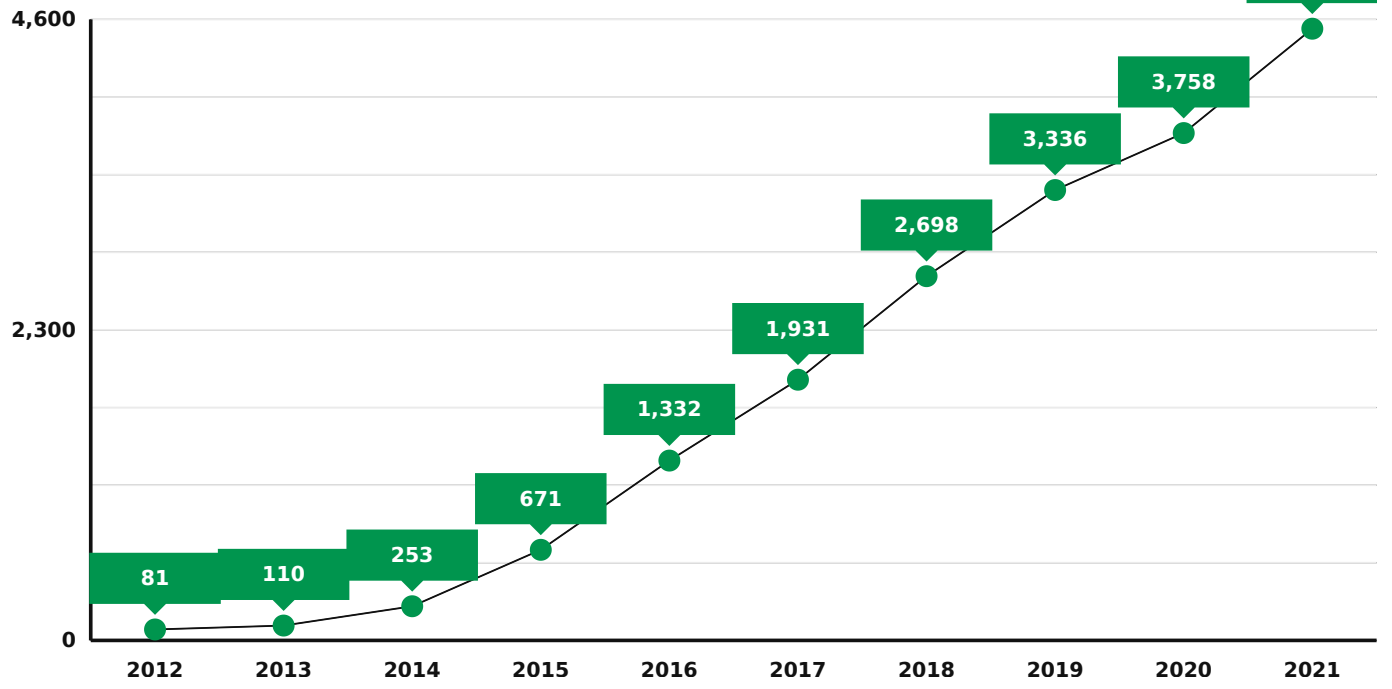


Percent of PrEP users, by Age, 2021

# PrEP-to-Need Ratio (PNR)

*The 2021 PrEP-to-Need Ratio (PNR) is the ratio of the number of PrEP users in 2021 to the number of people newly diagnosed with HIV in 2020. PNR serves as a measurement for whether PrEP use appropriately reflects the need for HIV prevention. A lower PNR indicates more unmet need.*

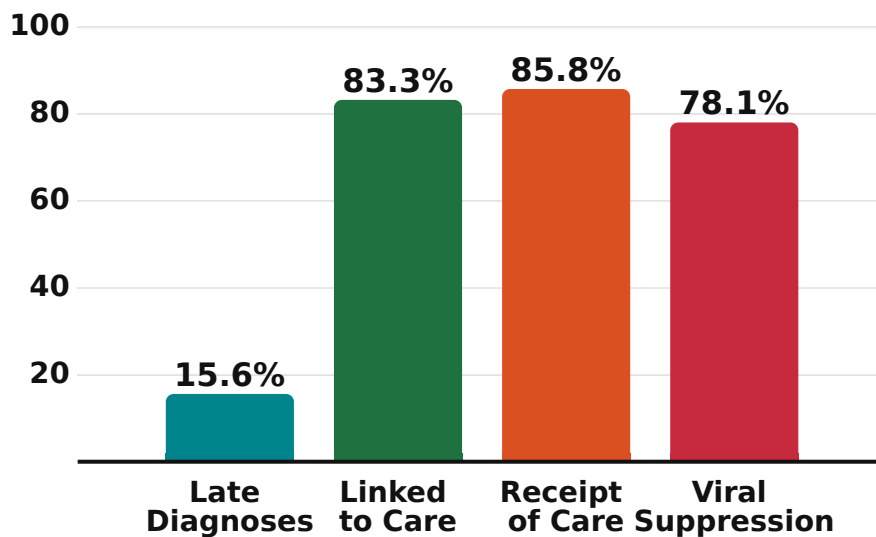

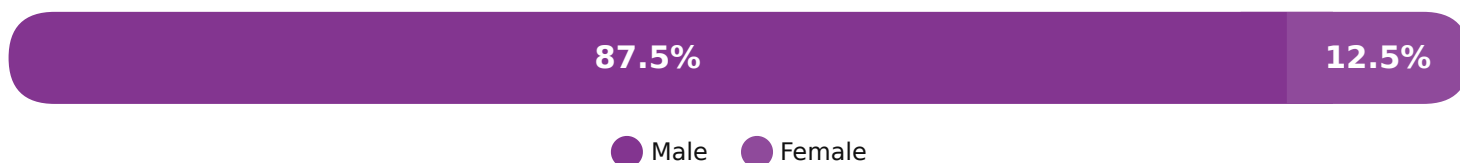

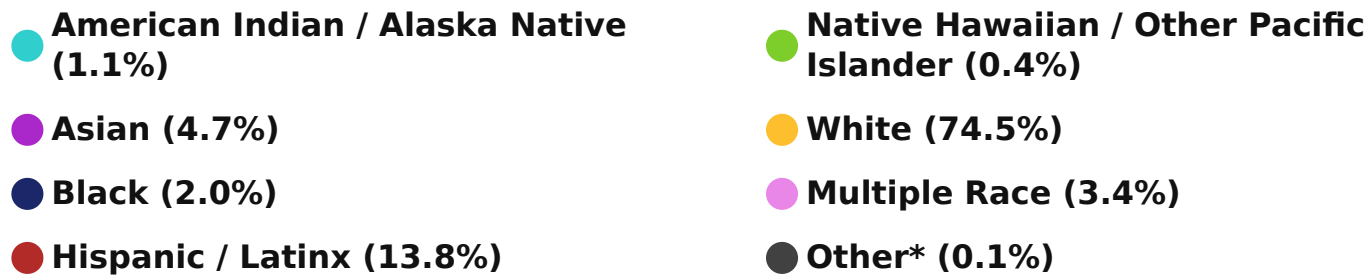

# HIV Prevalence Rate Ratios, by Race/Ethnicity, 2020

---

The rate of **Black males** living with an HIV diagnosis is 3.2 times that of **White males**.

---

The rate of **Hispanic/Latino males** living with an HIV diagnosis is 1.4 times that of **White males**.

---

The rate of **Black females** living with an HIV diagnosis is 12.3 times that of **White females**.

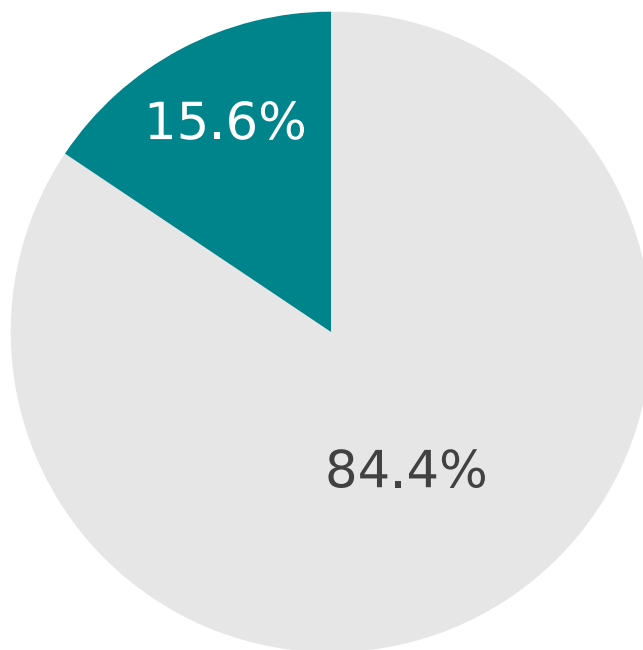
The rate of **Hispanic/Latina females** living with an HIV diagnosis is 1.5 times that of **White females**.



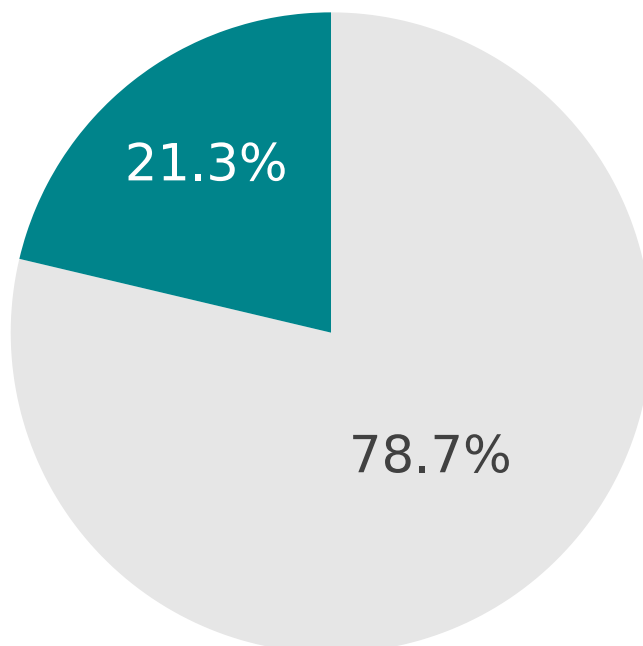

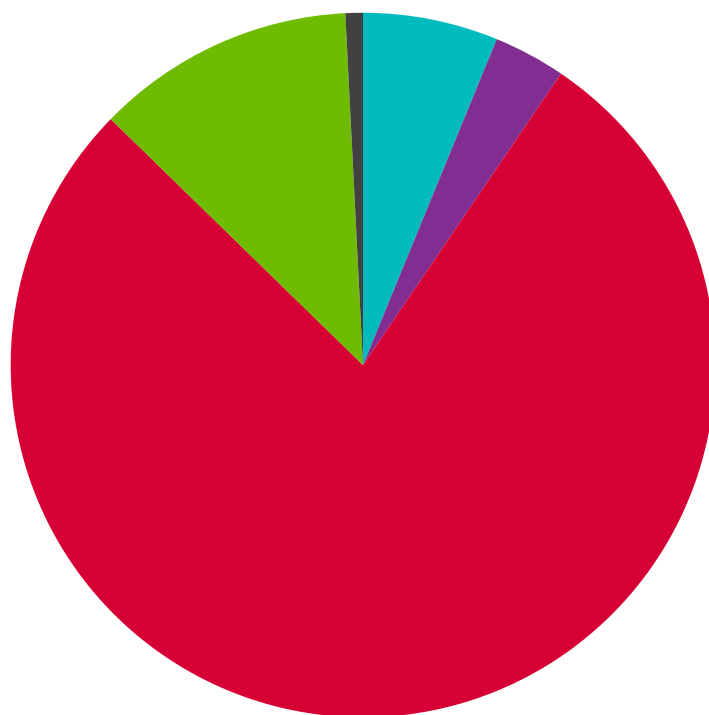

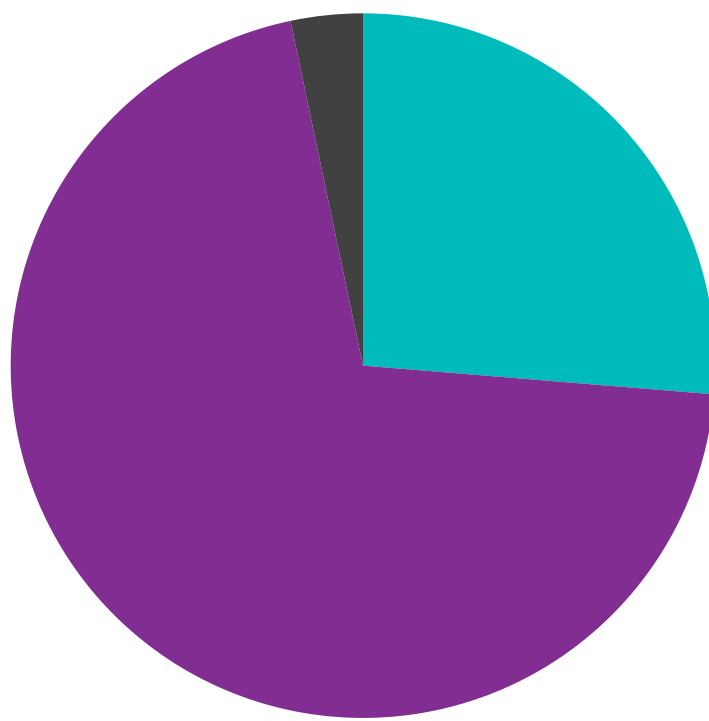

- **Other\* (3.3%)**

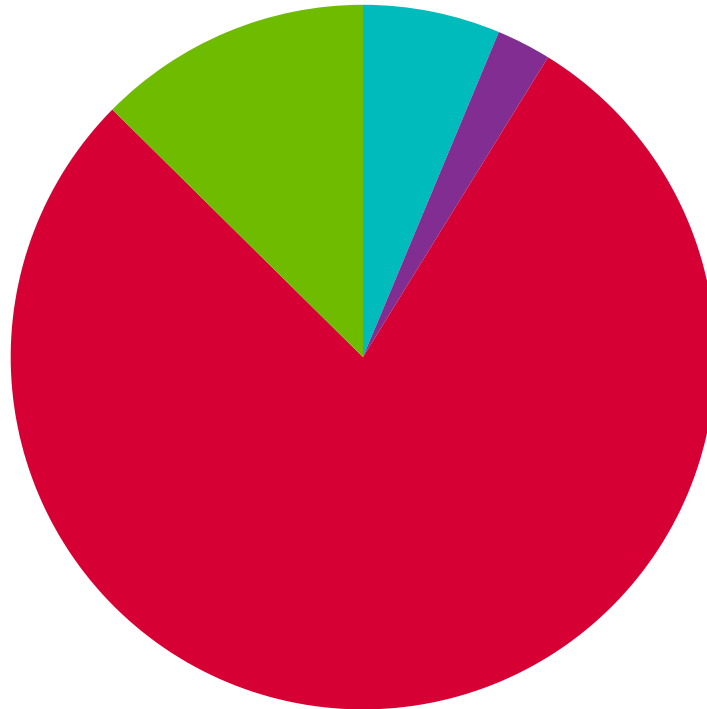

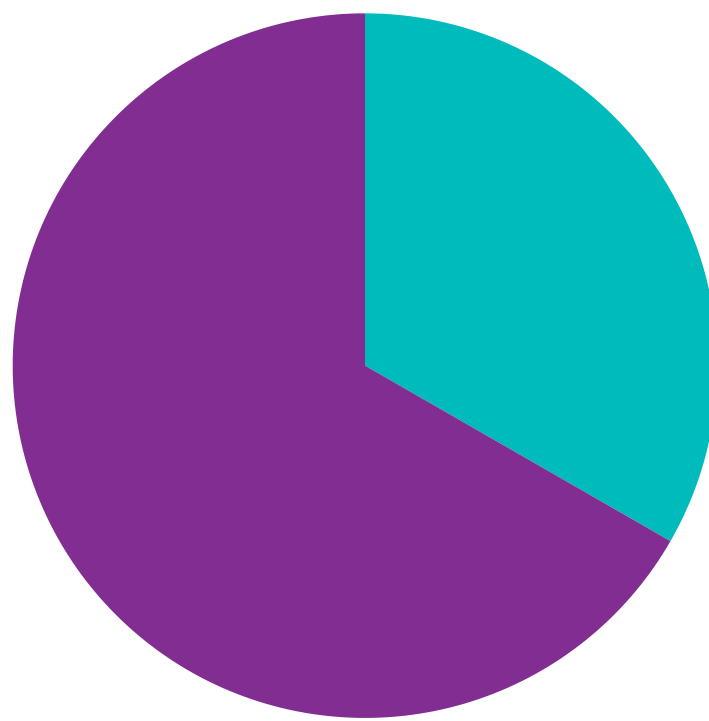

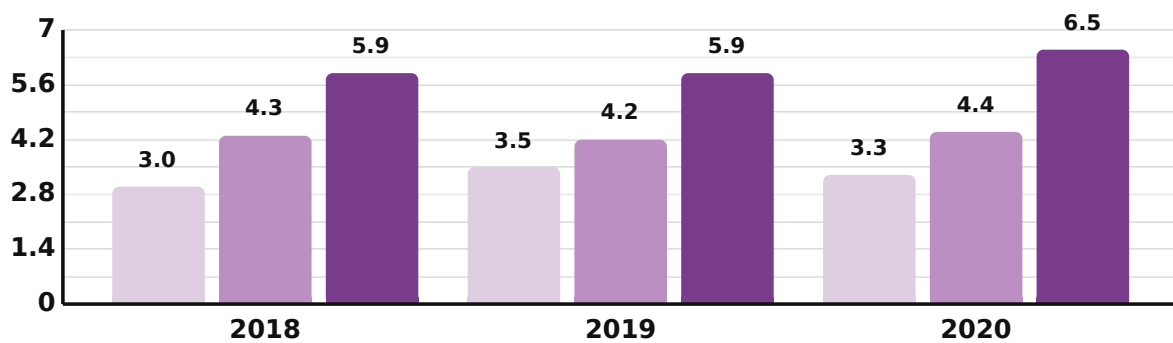

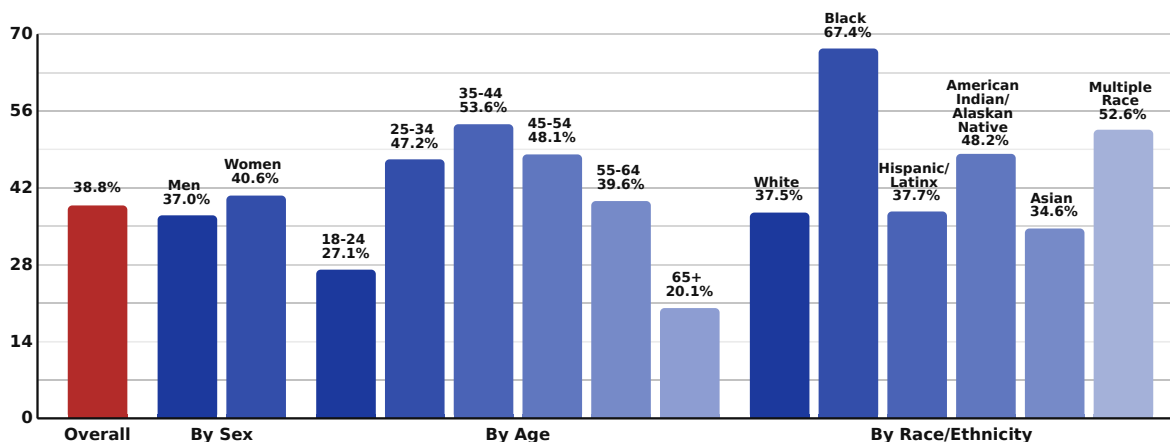

Mortality Rates of Persons Diagnosed with HIV per 100,000 population, 2018-2020

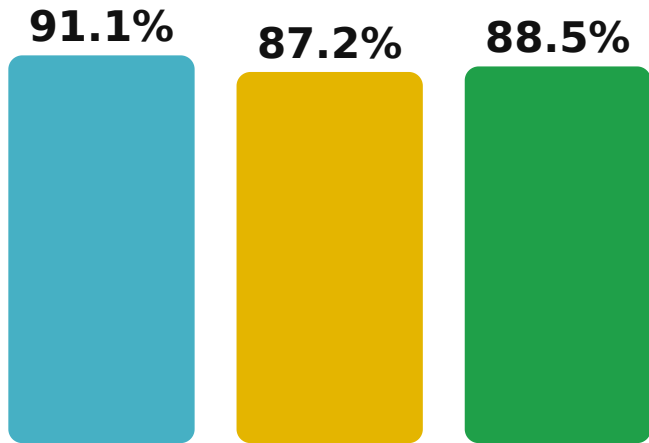
# HIV Testing, 2020

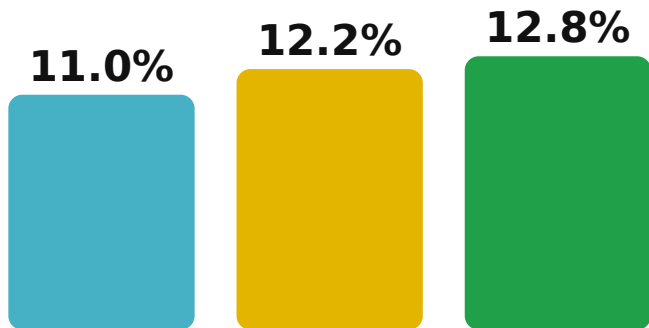

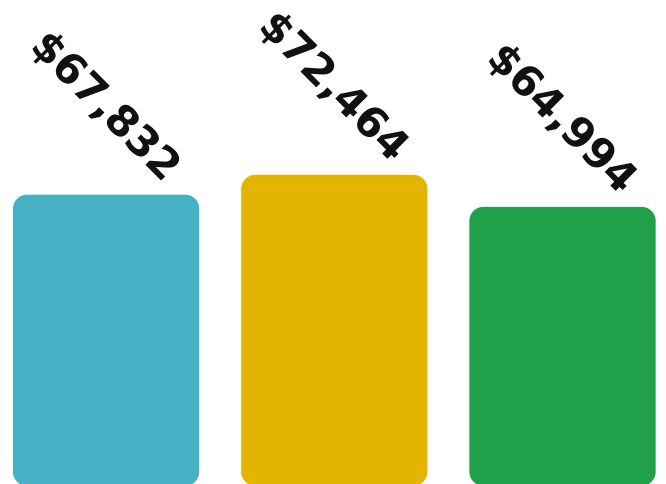
**Percent of Population with a High School Education, 2020**



**Income Inequality (Gini Coefficient), 2020**

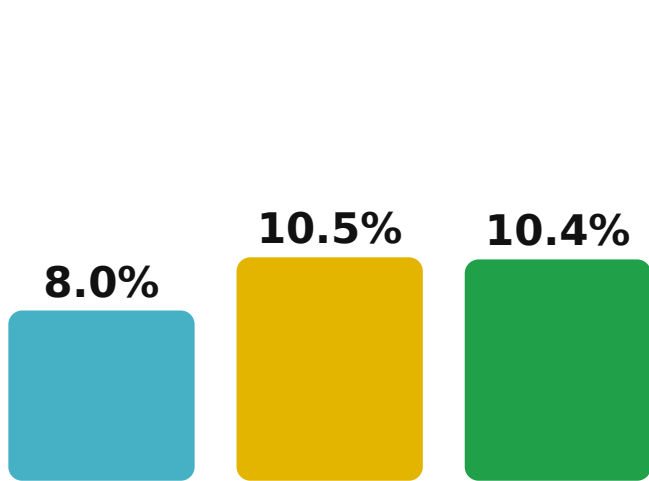


**Percent of Population Living in Poverty, 2020**

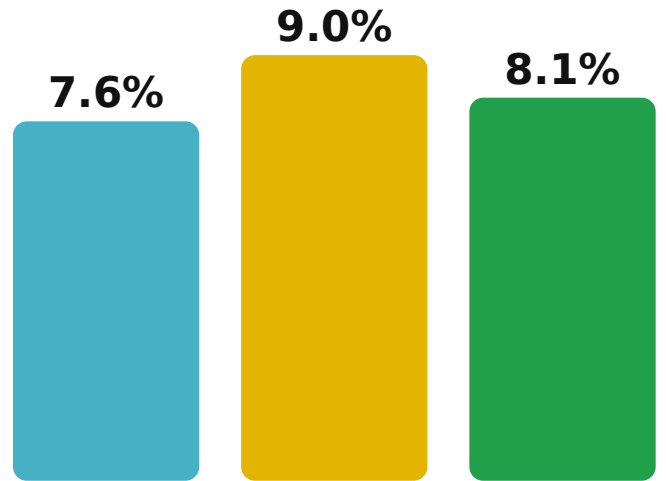


**Median Household Income, 2020**

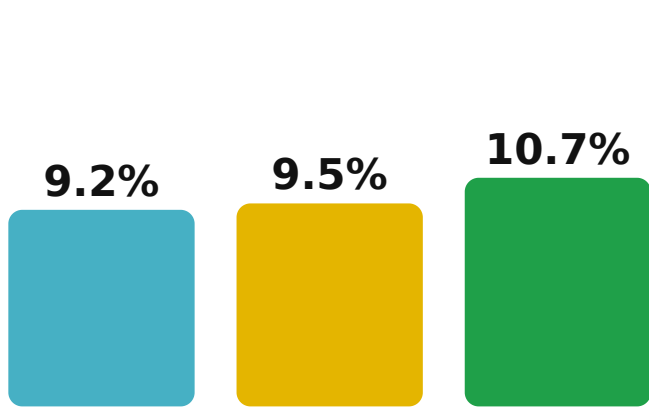




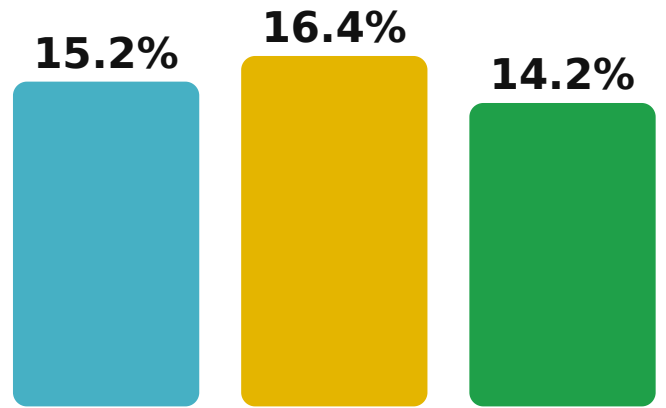
**Percent of Population (<65) Lacking Health Insurance, 2020**



**Percent of Population Unemployed, 2020**

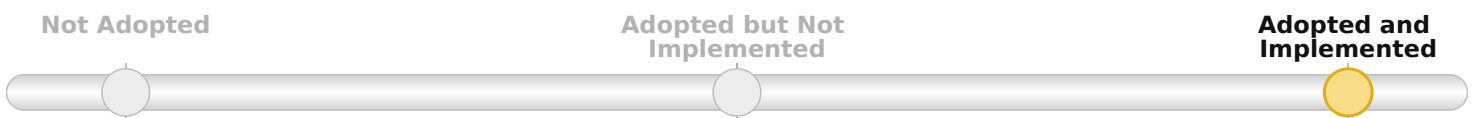


**Percent of Population Living with Food Insecurity, 2020**



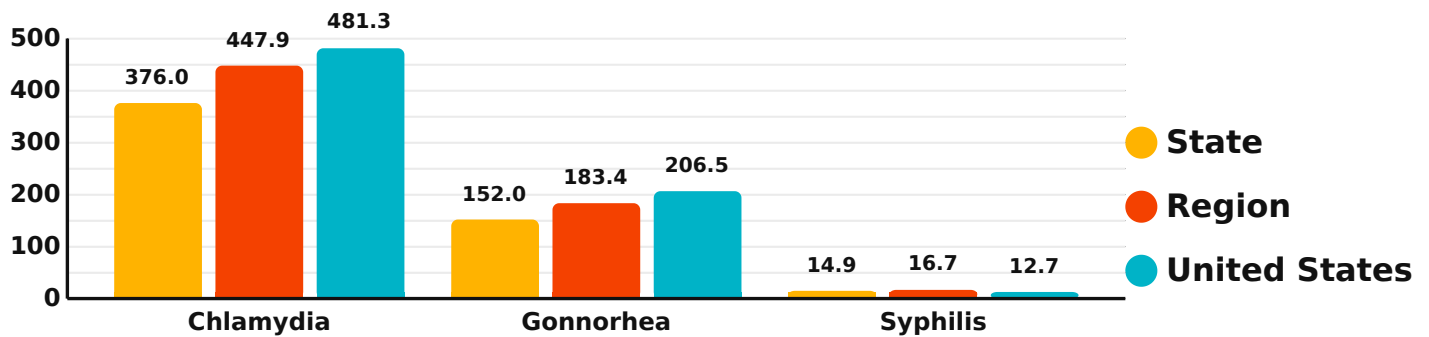
**Percent of Population Living in Unstable Housing, 2020**
